MAYORAL DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER
DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY – AMENDMENT TO
MARCH 20, 2020 DECLARATION**

WHEREAS, after reviewing the Governor of Texas Disaster Declaration made on March 19, 2020 and the Guadalupe County Judges State of Disaster made on March 20, 2020, I have determined that Section 6, 7 and 8 of my Local State of Disaster Declaration are not necessary.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED I, MAYOR WALTER C. WILLIAMS Jr OF THE CITY OF NEW BERLIN, TEXAS: DECLARE SECTION 6, 7 AND 8 ARE SUSPENDED.

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code the state of disaster for public health emergency shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of this declaration, unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of New Berlin, Texas.


